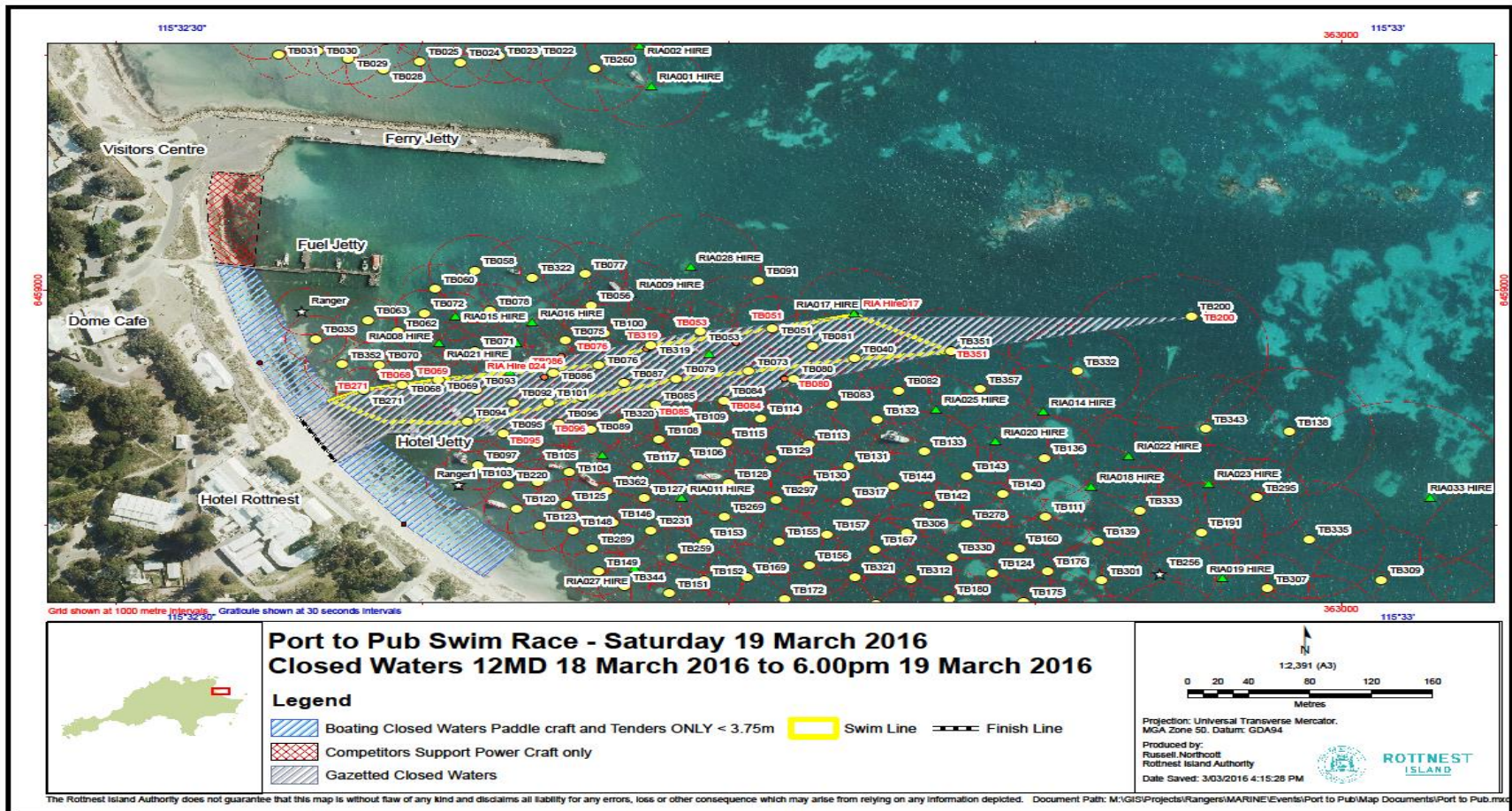

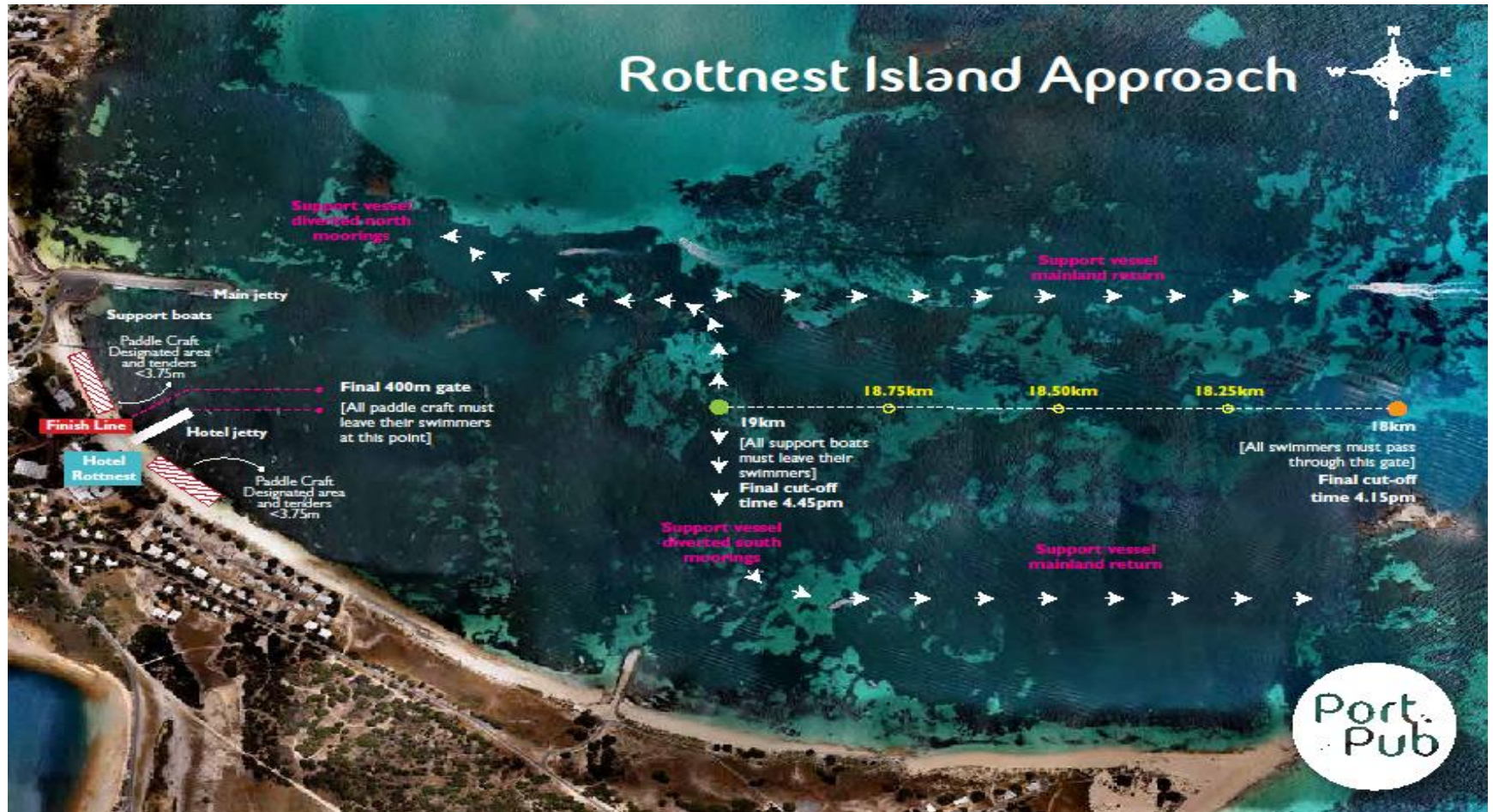


Arriving at Thomson Bay

Use of moorings

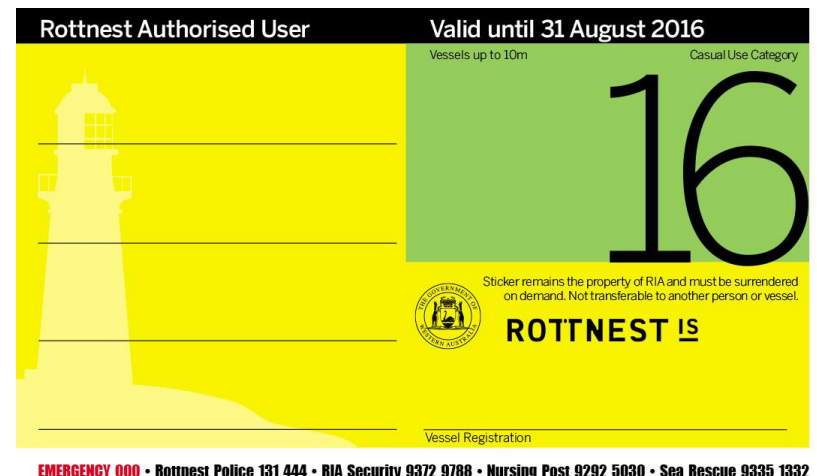
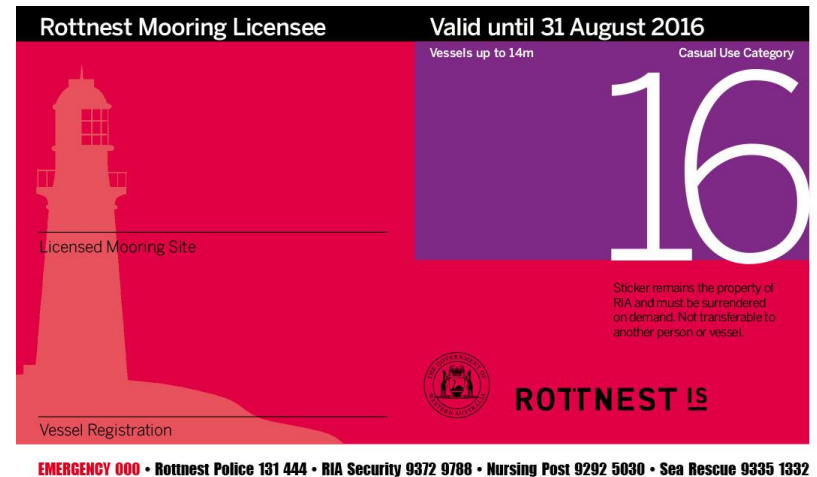

Finish Line set up

Admission fees apply to non-swimmers

- and can be paid online at www.rottnestisland.com

- No beach anchoring between the Fuel and Hotel Jetties (from midday Friday – 6:00pm Saturday)
- Competitors support craft must display their 2016 Port to Pub Swim sticker to access restricted beach landing areas.
- Tenders ONLY in demarcated areas
- Loading zones available on jetties (20 minutes max)

- Fuel (unleaded and diesel) is available at the Fuel Jetty 24/7.
- Only Master, Visa and debit cards are acceptable at the self service facility.
